- 2. US Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- 3. African American or African descent
- 4. High School Seniors expecting to graduate by June 2024, who will attend a 4-year College or University in September 2024.
- 5. Minimum GPA: C or 2.0/4.0 scale
